QUESTIONS

SCRIPTURE QUESTIONS

- What are the different ways God kept Moses safe when he was a baby?
- Why did Moses have to run away from Egypt?
- What message did Moses receive at the burning bush?
- Read Romans 12:9–10. Why do you think doing these things would make you a good leader?

APPLICATION QUESTIONS

- Do you like being a leader? Why or why not?
- Why do you think it's important to learn how to lead?
- What is one way you can lead this week?

ACTIVITY

Scan QR code for an example of a jungle journal kids can make by folding five pieces of paper in half and punching two holes along the crease. String a piece of yarn or twine through the holes and tie a knot. Have kids decorate with their own drawings or jungle-themed stickers.
