## **BIBLE**

Exodus 13:17–15:21; Psalm 91

## **QUESTIONS**

### ● **SCRIPTURE QUESTIONS**

- **In what ways did God lead the Israelites across the wilderness?** *God led them with a pillar of cloud by day and a pillar of fire by night.*
- **How were the Israelites trapped with no way out in today's Bible story?** *They were stuck between the Red Sea and Pharaoh's army chasing them.*
- **How did God rescue the people? How did the people respond?** *God parted the Red Sea, the people sang and danced.*
- **Read Psalm 91:2. What words from this verse remind you that God keeps you safe? How so?**

### ● **APPLICATION QUESTIONS**

- **What are some things that make you feel unsafe?**
- **How can God lead you to safety in these situations?**
- **Who can God use to help us be safe in those situations?**

## **ACTIVITY**

**Scan QR code** for instructions on a compass experiment kids can try using safety pins, paper clips, or hairpins, along with corks and refrigerator magnets to help them remember today's Big Idea. You could pass out a mini compass that they can take home afterward.
