BIBLE

Exodus 13:17-15:21; Psalm 91

QUESTIONS

SCRIPTURE QUESTIONS

- In what ways did God lead the Israelites across the wilderness? God led them with a pillar of cloud by day and a pillar of fire by night.
- How were the Israelites trapped with no way out in today's Bible story? They were stuck between the Red Sea and Pharaoh's army chasing them.
- How did God rescue the people? How did the people respond? God parted the Red Sea, the people sang and danced.
- Read Psalm 91:2. What words from this verse remind you that God keeps you safe? How so?

APPLICATION QUESTIONS

- What are some things that make you feel unsafe?
- How can God lead you to safety in these situations?
- Who can God use to help us be safe in those situations?

ACTIVITY

Scan QR code for instructions on a compass experiment kids can try using safety pins, paper clips, or hairpins, along with corks and refrigerator magnets to help them remember today's Big Idea. You could pass out a mini compass that they can take home afterward.
