## BIBLE

**The Word Became Flesh:** John 1:1–17; Psalm 80:1–7

## QUESTIONS

- Who is the "light" John is talking about? Jesus.
- True or False: John 1 says that Jesus was fully accepted by all people right away. False. The world did not recognize or receive him.
- What happens to people that do receive Jesus? They become children of God.
- Read Psalm 80:3,7. What is the psalmist asking God to do? "Make your face shine on us," save us, send us a savior.
- Is there any part of your life that feels a little dark, sad, confusing, or scary? What can you ask Jesus for?
- What are one or two things you can do during Advent this year (the time you spend waiting until Christmas)?
- Who can you tell about the reason God sent Jesus?

## ACTIVITY

Give each kid a mini beach ball and a permanent marker. Have them write the Big Idea and decorate it. Then have them inflate it and attach a bit of looped string to the nozzle to create an ornament.
