BIG IDEA

Jesus is why we celebrate!

BIBLE

Jesus is Born!Luke 2:1–20: Psalm 89:1–4

QUESTIONS

- Why did Mary and Joseph have to go Bethlehem? Because the ruler issued a census for the entire Roman world.
- Where did Mary place baby Jesus after he was born? In a manger.
- Who appeared to shepherds? What message did they give? Angels; that a Savior has been born and could be found lying in a manger.
- Read Psalm 89:3–4. How did God keep this promise to David? Jesus was born; God sent Jesus, who is from the line of David.
- Would you like it if every day was Christmas? Why or why not?
- How can you celebrate Jesus daily, even when it's not Christmas?
- If you could tell someone about why you celebrate Jesus at Christmas time in one sentence, what would you say?

ACTIVITY

Give kids <u>clear, fillable ornaments</u> (or use plastic cups, pipe cleaners, and paper for <u>a DIY version</u>) along with bits of kinetic sand, small assorted seashells, and a larger clamshell to write "Jesus is why we shell-ebrate!"
