

## **BIG IDEA**

## **BIBLE**

**The Faith of the Centurion:**  
Luke 7:1–10

## **QUESTIONS**

Pass around a bubble hourglass for kids to shake and invert. As they play, ask kids the questions below.

- **Who needed help because one of his workers was sick?** *The centurion (Roman officer).*
- **Who did he ask for help?** *Jesus.*
- **Did the centurion let Jesus come to his house?** *No. He said he believed Jesus could heal with only his words.*
- **Who can we pray to when we are sick or if someone we know is sick?** *Jesus!*

Remember, Jesus loves you! That's why we can pray to him when we are not feeling well. It makes me wanna say . . .  
**Wow! Jesus has the power to heal.**

## **ACTIVITY**

Give each kid two colorful jumbo [Band-Aids](#), googly eyes, and permanent markers. Supervise them carefully when using permanent markers so that they don't mark up anything other than their paper. Have kids use the two Band-Aids to create characters from the story. Allow them to decorate the rest of the page using crayons. **Scan QR code** for a worked example.
